What are we auctioning?

How do I take part?

Get an entry form from the “Poppy-Mobile” when it's selling Poppies on the Square on the Village Green. Or, download and print the form.

Then complete and sign the form and place it in an envelope. Seal the envelope then write your bid on the outside of that envelope, and date it. Place the sealed envelope in a larger envelope, seal it, and deliver it *either* back to the Poppy-Mobile *or* to 14 Teesway, Neasham, DL2 1QP. (Those collecting entry forms from the Poppy-Mobile will be supplied with envelopes).

Terms and Conditions

1. There is an undisclosed reserve price
2. The Auction closes at 10p.m. on Saturday 13 November 2021
3. Current bids may be recorded and disclosed by Neasham Parish Council during the course of the auction. The identity of the bidder will remain in the inner sealed envelope and will not be disclosed.
4. Entrants may lodge higher second or subsequent bid(s), accompanied by a further Entry Form
5. Following the close of the Auction, the inner envelope containing the highest bid will be opened.
6. In the event of competing highest bids, lots will be drawn amongst those bids before the relevant envelope is opened.
7. The successful bidder will be notified on Monday 15 November 2021
8. Payments must be made within 2 days of the successful bidder being notified, in cash or by cheque payable to "Royal British Legion".
9. Once made, bids may not be withdrawn.
10. The Parish Council will retain all entries until 30 November 2021, after which they will be promptly destroyed.
